Range:	Orchid
Vintage:	2010
Wine Style	Light-bodied white wine.
Grape Variety	Riesling
Growing Region	Frankland River, Western Australia.
Technical Details	Alc. 12.0% pH 2.87 TA 7.07 g/L RS 0.61 g/L
Appearance	Pale green.
Nose	Kaffir lime and scented floral notes.
Palate	Pure and dry, fresh lime, pink grapefruit and lemon zest with a long mineral and sherbet finish.
Vinification	Meticulous vineyard management is paramount to maintaining freshness and acidity. Grapes exposed on the warmer west side were removed prior to harvest, only retaining fruit sufficiently protected by canopy. The grapes were harvested early morning and crushed ever so gently to the press. Juice was patiently drained and settled prior to controlled fermentation.
Cellaring	Will benefit from up to 8 years careful cellaring.
Winemaker's Comments	This wine is bottled young but will also benefit from careful cellaring. Riesling is bottled having maintained most of its natural acidity, hence drinks well with food that has texture, depth and creaminess.
Serve	Slightly chilled 8-12 °C
Food	Enjoy with a crispy fillet of snapper.
