WINE NAME	Ferngrove Estate Shiraz
VINTAGE	2019
WINE STYLE	Medium-bodied red wine.
GRAPE VARIETY	95% Shiraz, 5% Malbec
GROWING REGION	Frankland River, Western Australia.
TECHNICAL DETAILS	Alc 14.5% pH 3.54 TA 6.18g/L RS 2.1g/L
APPEARANCE	Dark garnet.
NOSE	Hints of pepper and red berries on the nose.
PALATE	Ripe and rich with deep flavours of black plum, dark berries and hints of French oak and fine tannin. Medium-bodied with good texture and palate weight, leads to a medium long finish.
VINIFICATION	Our winemaking team visit the vineyard regularly as the fruit nears harvest to ensure we pick at the perfect balance of flavour, sweetness and acidity. The fruit was harvested and gently destemmed to our static fermenters. The wine receives regular pump overs and 'rack and returns' to ensure an even temperature and desirable level of colour and tannin extraction. Daily tastings of the ferment ensures the wine develops perfectly. The fermenter is then slowly drained overnight and the skins/seeds transferred gently by conveyor into our presses. The wine is blended from a combination of tank and older barrel matured wine after 12 months.
CELLARING	Cellar for up to 8 years.
SERVE	Serve at room temperature 18C.
FOOD	Spicy Satay beef skewers with fragrant jasmine rice topped with fresh coriander.
