| WINE STYLE | Medium-bodied red wine. |
| GRAPE VARIETY | Shiraz. |
| GROWING REGION | Western Australia. |
| TECHNICAL DETAILS | Alc 14% pH 3.5 TA 5.67g/L RS 1.74g/L |
| APPEARANCE | Crimson |
| NOSE | Displaying a combination of spice, pepper and vanilla on the nose complemented by ripe black plum. |
| PALATE | Textured and rich with hints of Satsuma plum, blackberries and French oak. |
| VINIFICATION | The grapes were harvested in the early morning and crushed to closed fermenters for maceration on skins prior to an 8 day ferment. The wine was drained and underwent malo-lactic fermentation prior to controlled maturation in a range of French oak for 11 months. |
| CELLARING | Enjoy now or cellar up to 5 years. |
| WINEMAKERS COMMENTS | Elegant, ripe red berry fruits on the palate, lovely oak integration and fine tannins delight the taste buds. |
| SERVE | At room temperature 18C. |
| FOOD | Serve with barbequed lamb. |
